<p>Locate a slide with a bulleted list. Click once on the text box to select it (the text box dotted line border will appear).</p>	
<p>Choose the Animations ribbon Click on Custom Animation The Custom Animation task pane will appear on the right.</p>	
<p>Click on Add Effect. Click on Entrance. Click on More Effects. Choose an effect. Click OK.</p>	
<p>Click on the drop arrow next to your animation. Click on Effect Options.</p>	
<p>On the Effect tab: Next to After animation select a medium color.</p>	

On the **Timing** tab:
Next to **Speed** select 1 seconds (Fast).



On the **Text Animation** tab:
Next to Group text select **By 2nd Level Paragraph**
Click **OK**
