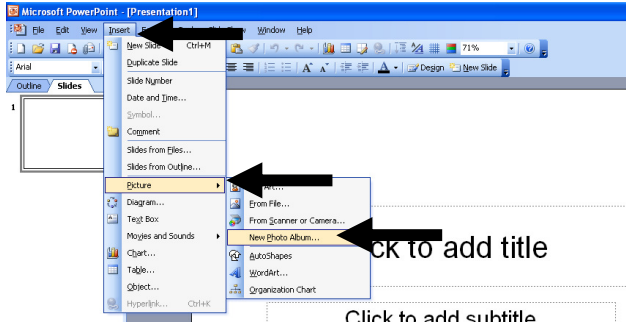


How to Make a PowerPoint Photo Album

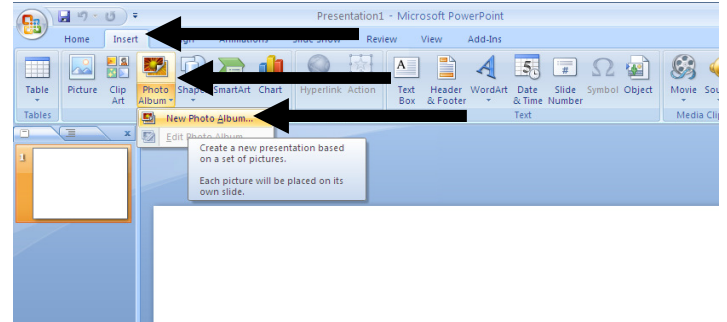
In Word 2003

Open **PowerPoint**.
 Click on **Insert**.
 Click on **Picture**.
 Click on **New Photo Album**.

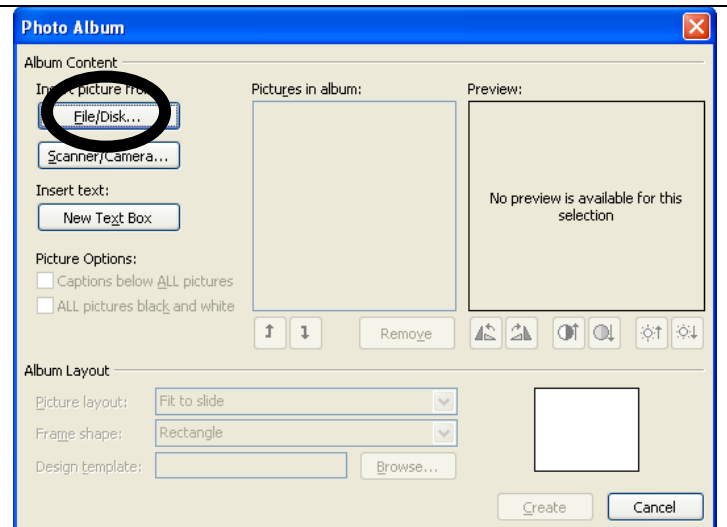


In Word 2007

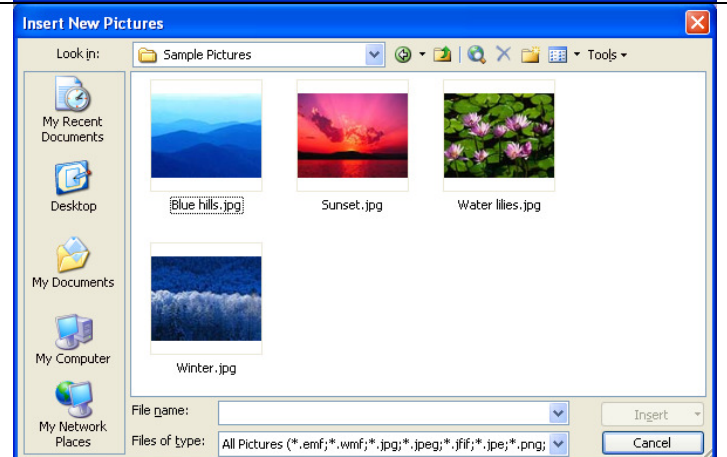
Open **PowerPoint**.
 Click on the **Insert** ribbon.
 Click on **Photo Album**.
 Click on **New Photo Album**.



You'll have to locate your pictures:
 Click on the **File/Disk...** button



Find your pictures.



To select ALL of your pictures:

Click on the **1st** image

Hold the **Shift** key

Click on the **last image**.

Let go of the **Shift** key.

Everything between the 1st and last click will be selected.

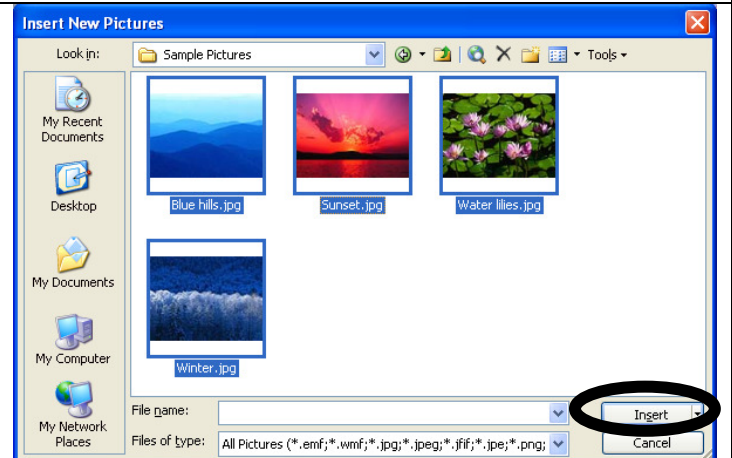
To select SOME of your pictures:

Hold the **Ctrl** key

Click on **each picture** you want in your slideshow.

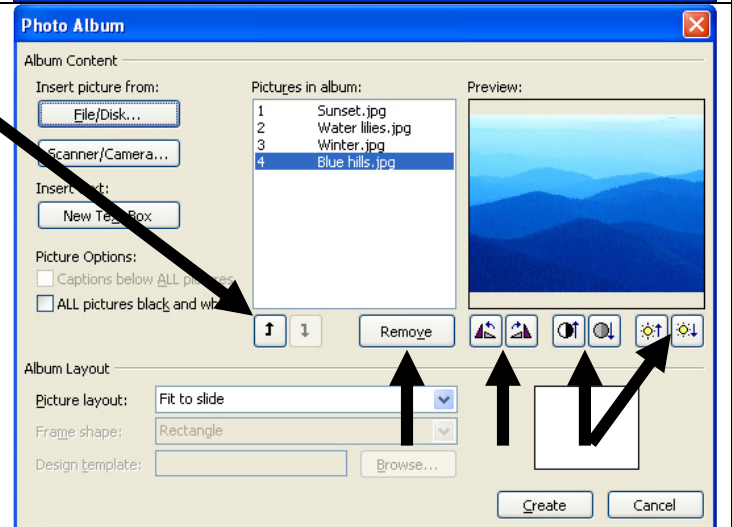
When finished, let go of the **Ctrl** key.

Click on **Insert**.

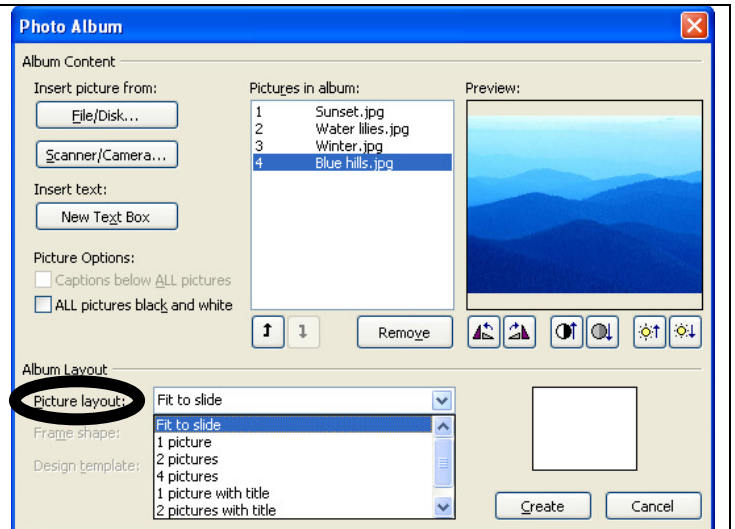


In this window, you can

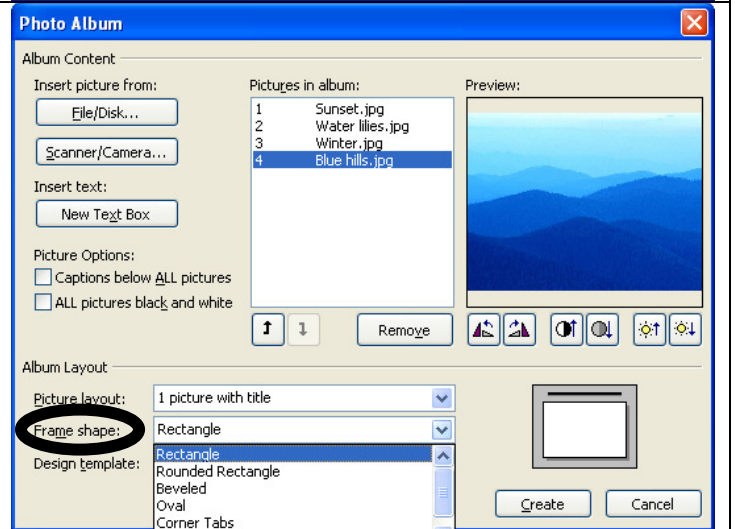
- Change the order of your images
- Remove a picture
- Rotate a picture
- Lighten/darken a picture



Now comes the oolala:
Click the drop down arrow next to **Picture Layout** to get choices – watch the preview to see what each choice will look like.



Click the drop down arrow next to **Frame Shape**: to get choices – watch the preview to see what each choice will look like.
Click the **Create** button and you have a PowerPoint Photo Album slideshow!



Change the name of the album (just click & drag thru the words **Photo Album** and type in your own title).
Add your name as the author of the album.
Choose a nice background for your slides
2003:Format > Background or Format > Slide Design
2007:Design ribbon>Themes or Background Styles
Be sure to SAVE!!!!
