








# Playing music in your slideshow 2007

<p>Open your PowerPoint slideshow. Click on the <b>Insert Ribbon</b>. Click on the <b>Sound icon</b>. Click on <b>Sound from File</b>.</p>	
<p>Locate your sound file (it MUST be in the same folder as your slideshow).  Click <b>OK</b>.</p>	
<p>Decide how you want the music to start – automatically or when clicked.</p>	
<p>The icon represents your music. You can move it to a corner to make it less intrusive. <i>Note: This icon will only work when you run your slide show – not in Normal view.</i></p>	
<p>Click on the <b>Animation Ribbon</b>. Click on the <b>Custom Animation icon</b>. <b>Custom Animation</b> will appear in the right side <b>Task Pane</b>.</p>	
<p>Your music will appear in the Task Pane (on the right). Click on the <b>drop arrow</b> for a new menu. Click on <b>Effect Options</b>.</p>	
<p>On the <b>Effect</b> tab Under <b>Stop playing</b> Click on <b>After</b> Change the number to however many slides you want the music to play. Click <b>OK</b>.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Save.</b> Play your slideshow!</p>
